## **Hodge Hall Self-Guided Tour**

Self-guided tours begin in Hodge Hall Commons, just inside the 10th Street and Fee Lane entrance to Hodge Hall.

- Proceed through the Commons and up the stairs. Many students use this space to study, rest, or meet up with friends.
- 2. Look to your left toward the double doors: Beyond these doors on the right is an RPS Cafe, one of three nearby (additional locations are in O'Neill and Wells Library). If you choose to explore the cafe, return to this point before you resume the tour.
- **3. Turn right just before the elevators on the right.** Notice a few Kelley classrooms as you walk down the hall.
- **4. On your left is the K-Cove (computer stations).** Staffed by expert peer tutors, this academic service is provided to students seeking support in computer skills courses like K201. Keep going past K-Cove. Take the hall to your right to find staircase M.
- 5. Take the stairway up to the third floor. Hodge stairways feature a legacy of generous alumni, including the namesake of the school, Ed Kelley.
- **6. To your left is HH 3038.** This suite is home to the Business Honors and International Programs offices.
- 7. On your right is HH 3035. One-on-one academic advising is available here for all admitted Kelley majors via drop-in or appointment. This suite also houses Kelley Student Support, promoting wellness and balance initiatives around the school.
- 8. Continue past 3035. At the end of the hall, go down staircase L (near classroom 3016). On your right, take a look at the Aron Investment Center, room 2016.
- Continue down this hall. To the right is HH 2030. This suite is home to several undergraduate program offices: Kelley Institute for Social Impact, Kelley Office of Access and Community Enhancement, and Student Life.
- 10. As you go down the hall past 2030, you'll see the largest classrooms, 2075 and 2083. The Kelley Hall of Honor can be found on the left. Take a pic with the Kelley seal! Continue down this hall and take the elevators down to the first floor to find the Balance Room. Past the Balance Room is the Prebys Career Center. You'll find the Undergraduate Admissions Office on the second floor of Prebys.
